He is a Public Health Specialist and a Health System Administration with 15 years of hands-on experience. He oversees the health of all uniform personnel, MoD employees, and their families. He is the program coordinator for US DoD sponsored HIV & AIDS Program (DHAPP). Dr. Kowo serves as an Adjoint Faculty at the Cuttington Graduate School where he lectures on “*Strategic Management in Healthcare*” and

“Healthcare Policy and Management”. He has led the Health response during two major outbreaks including Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) and the COVID-19 pandemic.
