



Lieutenant General Dato' (Dr) Zulkeffeli bin Mat Jusoh graduated from the Army Medical College Pakistan in 1991. He also has a Master Degree in Public Health and a Post Graduate Diploma in Aviation Medicine from the Royal College of London UK. He was trained in Aerospace Medicine and Aircraft Accident Investigation in United States as well as Aeromedical Evacuation in Australia. He served Malaysian Armed Forces in various capacities for the past 30 years with the first unit at the 22nd Special Forces Regiment as Medical Officer. He also served as the Force Medical Officer with the UN Mission in Western Sahara and subsequently seconded to the Ministry of Science Technology and Innovation (MOSTI) then as the Program Director for Malaysian Astronaut Program in 2007 for the launch of the first Malaysian Astronaut to International Space Station (ISS). He is also the advisor of the Health Informatics Committee overseeing the health ICT initiatives within the MAF Health Services.

In an effort to help the country curb the COVID-19 pandemic, he has been appointed to lead the vaccination program in Malaysian Armed Forces. Starting from Mei 2021, he serves as the Director General of Malaysian Armed Forces (MAF) Health Services Division of the MAF Headquarters MINDEF Malaysia till now. In his role, he has been prominent in leading Malaysia's response to the COVID-19 pandemic such as initiated deployment of Malaysian Field Hospital in Kedah, Penang, Johor, Sabah and Sarawak. Lieutenant General Dato' (Dr) Zulkeffeli bin Mat Jusoh was also appointed to be the Strategic Management Group of Greater Klang Valley Special Task Force organization in collaboration with Ministry of Health.
